Did you know you can give to WBC straight from your IRA without paying taxes on the amount?

If you are 70½ or older, you can use a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) to send money from your IRA straight to the church and that amount is generally not included in your taxable income.

Why Choose a QCD?

- Tax Savings: Lower your taxable income and make a difference at the same time.
- Meet Your RMD: If you are 73 or older, QCD gifts can count toward your Required Minimum Distribution.
- Flexible Giving: You can make a one-time gift or set up monthly transfers, up to \$111,000 per year for 2026.
